What is the official language and are there more languages spoken?

The official language is Croatian. Despite Croatia is a pretty small country there are many dialects that differ sometimes from village to village and it isn't rare case that two people, each from another end of the country can barely understand each other.

What are typical dishes of your country?

Zagorski strukli – very common dish in the northern part of Croatia made of special kind of pastry filled with cheese and baked.

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The most common dish in the middle part in Croatia is spit-roasted lamb, and on the south is fish and all sea food of course.

What are typical beverages of your country?

Sljivovica – a very strong brandy made of plums. Well known to all the foreign people (from my experience). The other kinds of brandies are Travarica (made of grass), Lozovaca (made of grapes) etc.

Sljivovica is a typical beverages and it is mostly drunk in the middle part of Croatia, while on the north and on the south there are homemade wines which differ a lot from those made on north and on south.

When visiting your country what should a visitor not miss?

The first thought of everyone who thinks about Croatia is a beautiful sea side, nice beaches and islands. That is certainly one of the things that shouldn't be missed when visiting Croatia. The other things are wonderful national parks (Plitvicka Jezera, Paklenica, Nacionalni park Krka, Kornati, Brijuni...), mountains, lakes.
